## OUR HISTORY & ACHIEVEMENTS

**Nucleo was founded in 2013 with a simple idea - we believe that every child should have the opportunity to learn music.**

We started in a North Kensington flat, aspiring to support and bring together young people from all corners of this diverse and varied West London community.

Back then we were run by just one volunteer teacher, and at our first rehearsal there were only four aspiring musicians in our orchestra!

Now we work with over 450 children and young people who attend over 100 different schools and provide hundreds of much-needed free instruments to young musicians across the UK.

# NUCLEO'S JOURNEY

We now have a waitlist of over 300 students, and plans to expand our programme across London and the UK to meet the need of this incredible work.

## LEAVING A RESIDUAL LEGACY

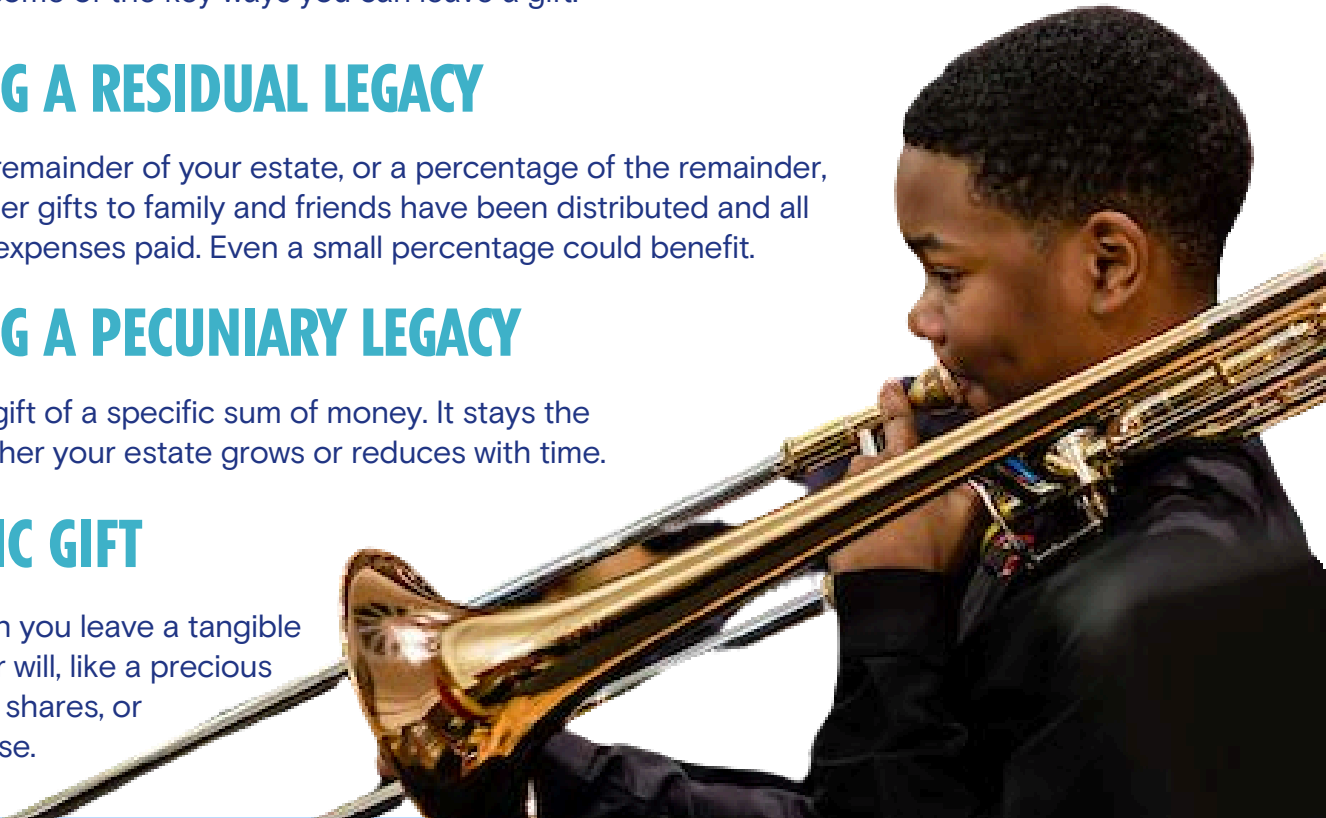
